

Step One: Predict

The purpose: To activate interest and bring out our prior knowledge, preconceptions, and assumptions regarding the data with which we are about to work. Prediction allows dialogue participants to share the frame of reference through which they view the world and lays the foundation for collaborative inquiry.

The steps include:

1. Clarify the questions that can be answered by the data
2. Make predictions about data
3. Identify assumptions behind each prediction

Prediction Sentence Starters:

I predict . . . I expect to see . . . I anticipate . . .

Assumption Questions:

Why did I make that prediction?
What is the thinking behind my prediction?
What do I know that leads me to make that prediction?
What experiences do I have that are consistent with my prediction?

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
