What is the work you will be doing?

Students will be responsible for hands-on assembling in a clean room environment of electrical and mechanical sub- and final assemblies while following safe work practices. The intern understands the manufacturing assembly process, the set up and flow of assembly procedures, recognizes potential problems and helps to resolve them by bringing them to the attention of a product team lead or Supervisor in a timely manner, assists in setting up and maintaining production flow, works with minimum supervision, as required. In addition there will be weekly face-to-face time with manufacturing engineers.
